1. Must be a player on your tournament roster.

3. If you are in more than one tourney, please choose a different player for each tourney.
4. Nomination can come from coach, AD, principal, athletic council, or any combination.
5. There will be no repeat winners.
6. The tournament winner will be selected by the northern Indiana FCA office.
7. Each nominee will receive a certificate in the mail after the tournament.
